Eligibility:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Minimum 3 years taiko experience, or an equivalent combination of experience in taiko and other performing arts
- Applicants must submit an application form, 10-15 minute audition video, and an application essay
- One-year commitment required with the possibility for renewal
